SPACE REQUIREMENTS

Dan can set up his booth almost anywhere, in almost any configuration. All that is needed is space for 8 portable folding bookcases, space for a folding 2'x5' table, and access to an electrical outlet for a powerstrip. Set up and tear down are approximately 90 minutes each way. Many facilities fit the bill, a large living room, dining room, church classroom, large hallway, garage, etc.
